Charles Swedlund was born in Chicago in 1935 and has lived all his life here. He studied at The Institute of Design of The Illinois Institute of Technology where he received the degrees, Bachelor and Master of Science in Photography. He has taught in the Chicago high schools and at the Young Men's Jewish Council, conducting classes also in the Adult Education Program of the Chicago Board of Education and directing a series of television programs on photography for Channel 11 (WTTU). These activities have been accompanied, during the past six years, by much work in illustrative and advertising photography.

At present he is teaching Ektacolor printing at The ~~Art~~ Institute of Design, Orientation Photography at The Art Institute of Chicago and Basic Photography at Wright Junior College.

His work has been published in Aperture, Art In America, Rangefinder and in two portfolios of Student Independent. The present exhibition is the first one-man showing of his work in color. All of the prints were made by Charles Swedlund in Ektacolor.
